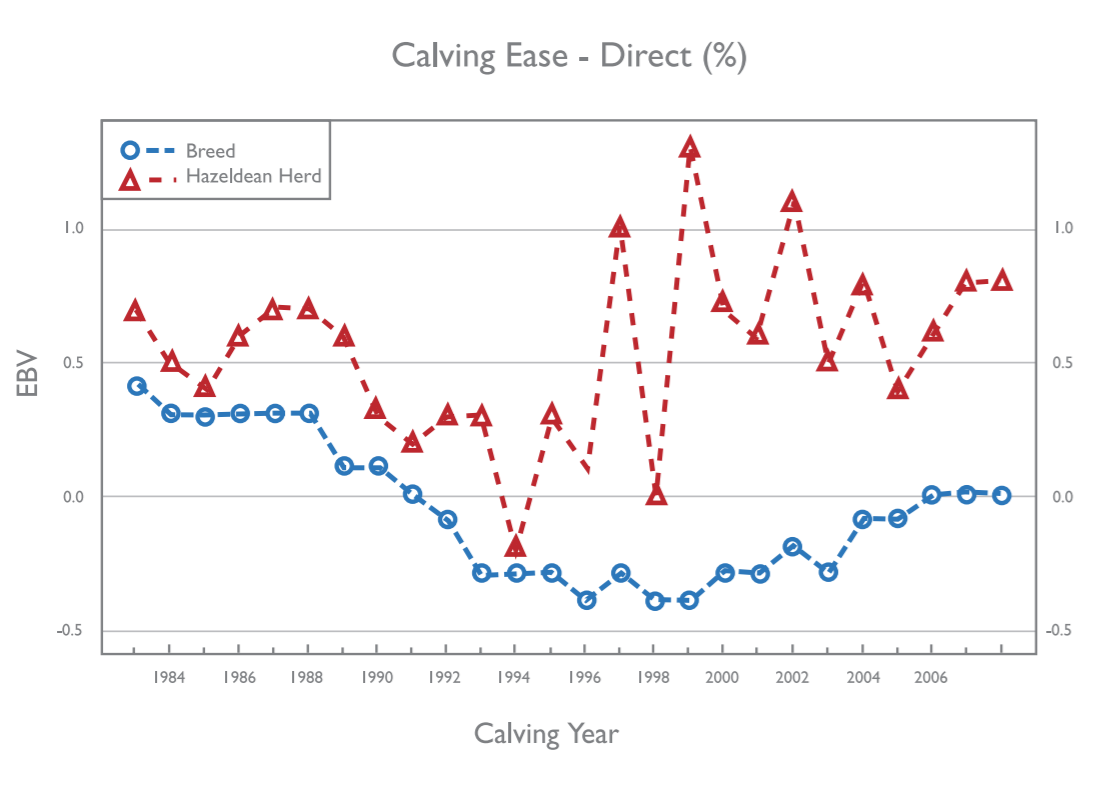
Our cattle have low birthweights, meaning more live calves and less stress on females...



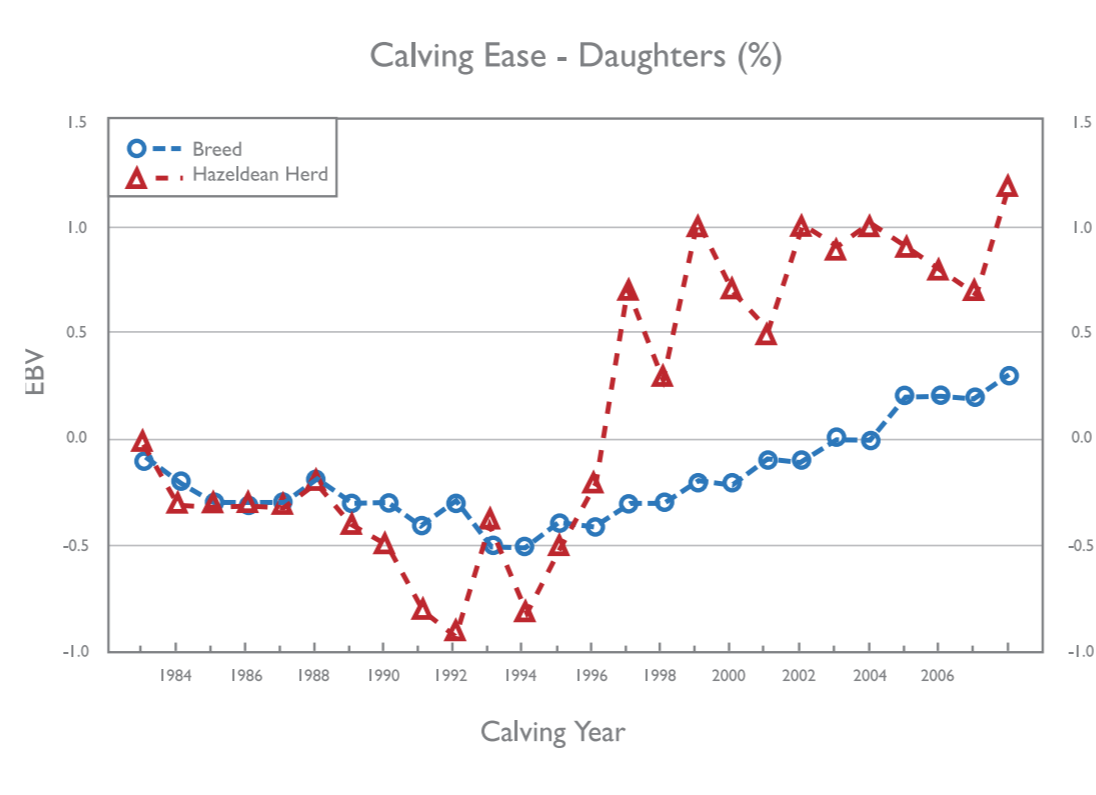
... yet growth is above breed average giving you heavier steers...



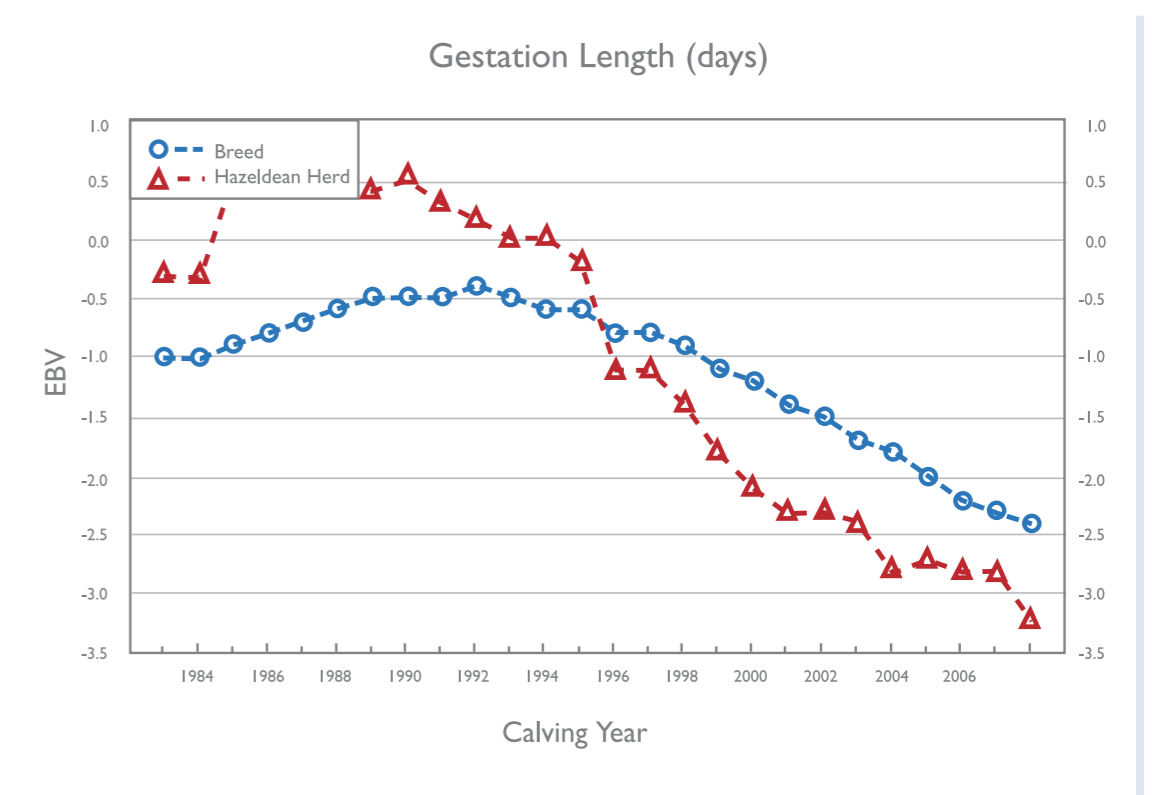
... and our females have shorter days to calving so they breed back sooner..



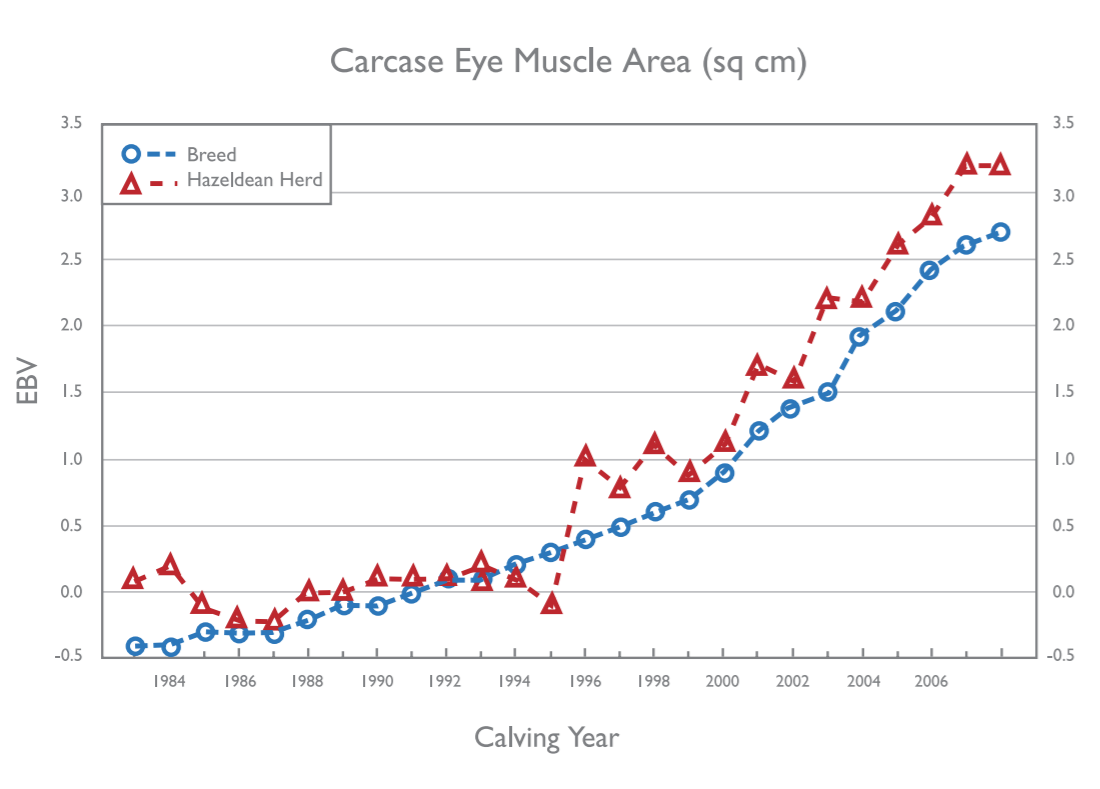
..... with far fewer calving difficulties...



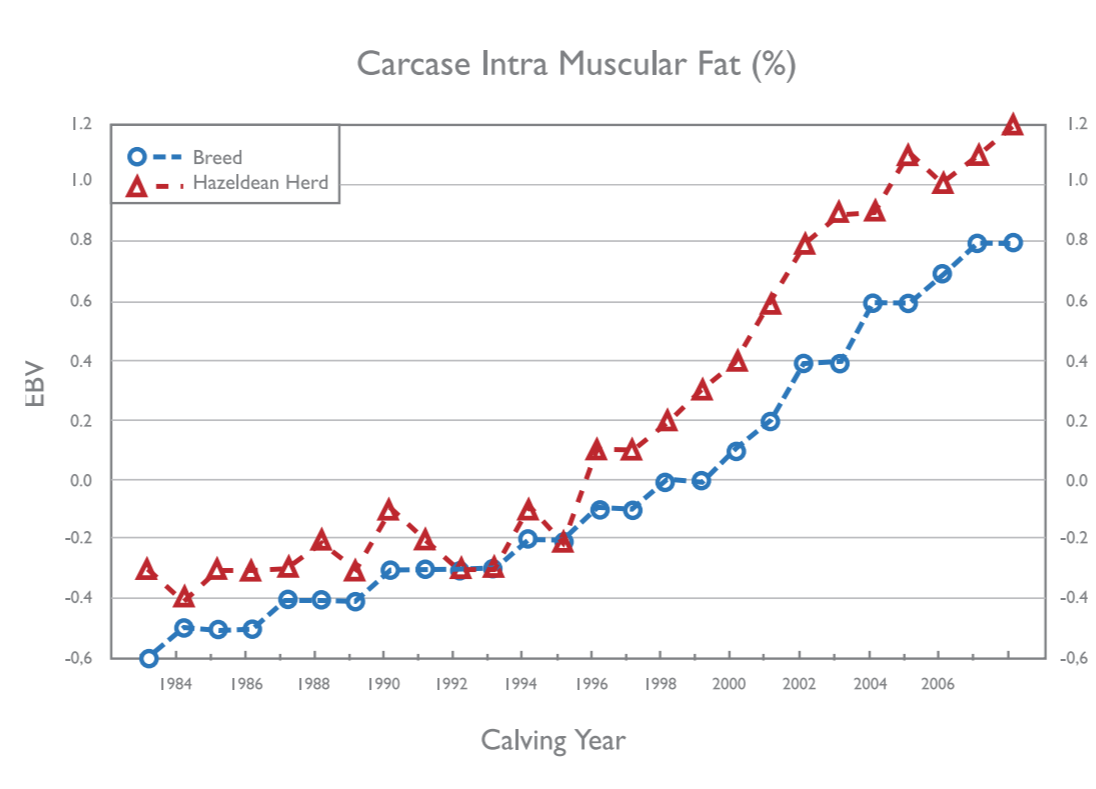
... and our bulls sire daughters with superior calving ease too.....



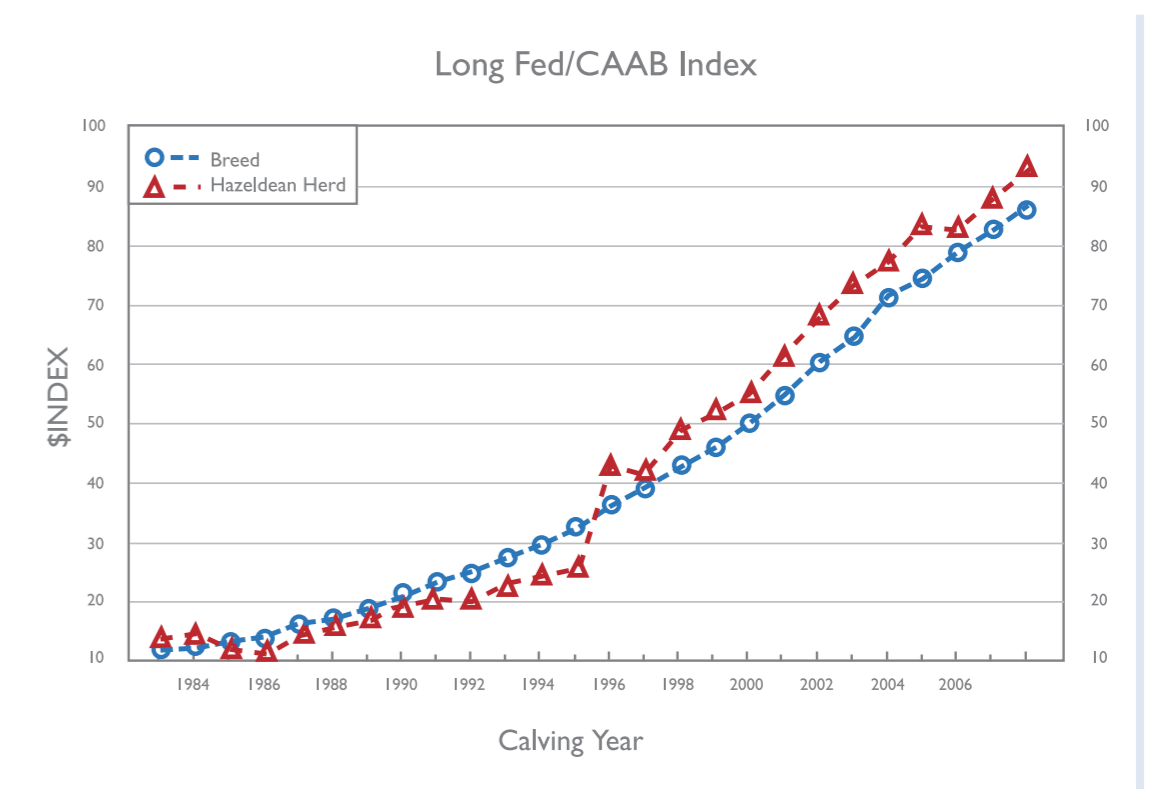
... and shorter gestation length, meaning lower birthweights and more time to get back in calf again for next year...
