
We've been doing new things for a long time

The most experience

Since 1954 stud rams have been selected based on fleece weights and fibre quality, making Hazeldean the stud that has implemented objective performance and breeding for the longest time in Australia.

Back yourself with our genetics

Our long history of stringent performance based selection mean that our sheep carry and disseminate robust genetics. Backed with breeding depth unmatched by any other stud, the use of Hazeldean genetics will consistently produce the most profitable sheep.



Ram Selection

The gains made by the Hazeldean program are quantifiable, permanent and compound over time.



Sales take place in October and November. Sale grades are established on the basis of performance ranking. The very highest value rams are auctioned, the rams with the next highest value are placed in our top private selection grade and so on.

Sale Grades

Auction & \$1000 grade - top 50% on fleece value

\$800 grade - next 25% on fleece value

\$650 grade - next 25% on fleece value

Reserve rams – in February we hold our Annual Hazeldean Woolgrowers Breakfast and Elite Sire Sale. These rams are the most highly tested, with the most accurate performance data on offer - a unique opportunity to source these industry leaders just



Ewe Selection

The Hazeldean ewe flock numbers some 13,000 ewes and while only the best 3,500 of these are used for ram production, the size of the flock makes it arguably the largest single Merino genetic resource in Australia.

Breeding depth & consistency

In addition to its scale, the Hazeldean ewe flock is unique in its depth and consistency of breeding. The creation of a selection procedure, ongoing now for nearly 50 years, of measured economic value, rather than aesthetic characteristics, has meant the Hazeldean flock has a consistency of production and commercial worth compounded and entrenched throughout its entire genetic profile.
